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## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, gem set, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, wide, low half round, tapered band of 4.73mm width (at base) x 0.99mm depth, with a hollow top and shoulders, open back settings and a curved underrail.

Feature central square top plate, housing sixteen Princess cut diamonds, invisibly set. Surrounding is one inner row of twenty round brilliant cut diamonds, and one outer row of thirty-four round brilliant cut diamonds, all claw set. There is also one middle row of fifty-one baguette cut and tapered baguette cut diamonds, channel set. The top plate is supported with an open wire base, and is secured between the tapering shoulders, of the plain and polished band. The shoulders are embellished with a pierced decorative pattern.



Polished finish. Stamped '750 GK 655' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: L. The ring contains:

Sixteen invisibly set Princess cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "G".

Dimensions (average) = 2.50mm(L) x 2.50mm(W) x 1.77mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 1.44ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fifty Four bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 1.94mm(Dia) x 1.18mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 1.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fifty One channel set baguette cut and tapered baguette cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si & P1", colour is "G to I" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 2.46mm(L) x 1.42mm(W) x 1.04mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 1.56ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 11.90 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 4.50ct Total Metal Weight = 11.00 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
