

Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand-assembled raised sterling silver & gemset, flexible link bracelet.

Feature; "single line style" bracelet. Comprising, fifty six four claw railed settings, housing fifty six round, faceted cut black diamonds, claw set. The bracelet is articulated with open back settings, underneath, having a tongue in box clasp closure, with 2 x figure 8 safety clips attached one to each side.



Bracelet dimensions = 19.00cm (total length inclusive) x 3.44mm (width) x 4.16mm (depth).



Fifty Six claw set round, faceted cut diamonds, clarity is "P3+", colour is "black opaque", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 3.00mm (average diameter) x 1.83mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 3.20mm (average diameter) x 1.95mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 6.00ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 13.24 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 6.00ct, Total Metal Weight = 12.04 grams (estimated)

Note: Limited gemmological testing, inset. The black gemstones may possibly be treated black diamond or treated synthetic black moissanite. Limited testing, whilst set, cannot determine the nature of these gemstones. Therefore, the black gemstones require removal from their settings for full and accurate gemmological testing. The exact dimensions of the black gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the black gemstones are very much estimated. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar line style bracelet employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
