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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 14ct vellow gold, gem set, multistone, 'three stone' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 2.34mm width (at base) x 0.60mm depth, with hollow top and shoulders, open back settings, and a curved underrail shank.

Feature three central four claw settings, each housing one oval emerald, claw set. Surrounding each setting is one row of round brilliant cut and single cut diamonds, claw set. There are a total of thirty round brilliant cut and single cut diamonds. The top plate has an open wire base, and is secured between the extended and square shoulders of the plain and polished band.



Polished finish. Stamped '14K BH' - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Ring size: P.

The ring contains:

Three claw set oval shaped natural emeralds, colour is "medium green".

Dimensions (average) = 5.12mm(L) x 3.94mm(W) x 1.83mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.63ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Thirty claw set round brilliant cut and single cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.23mm(Dia) x 0.75mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.50mm(Dia) x 0.92mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.24ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.10 grams

Total Gemstone Weight = 0.87ct

Total Metal Weight = 2.93 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
