## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One, 9ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, multistone, gem set ring, of cast construction. Plain, narrow, tapered band of 2.25mm in width (at base) x 1.35mm depth, with hollow top and shoulders, and open back settings.

Feature central navette-shape setting, housing eleven round brilliant cut and single cut (mixed) diamonds, tapering in size, bead set. Surrounded by a single row of twenty-six single cut diamonds, also bead set. All secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band. Each shoulder having a three row design, ten baguette cut and tapered baguette cut (mixed) diamonds, tapering in size, channel set. To each side is a single row, each bead set with eight single cut diamonds, also tapering in size. Polished finish - stamped '375 JP02' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Finger size is Q.



The ring contains:

Seven bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'P1 & P2' (mixed), colour 'H'.

Dimensions (average) = 1.60mm(Dia) x 0.98mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) Total Weight = 0.12ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Sixty Two bead set single cut diamonds, clarity 'Si', colour 'G to I' (mixed).

Dimensions = 0.95mm (diameter) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.10mm (diameter) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.38ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twenty channel set baguette cut & tapered baguette cut (mixed) diamonds, clarity 'Vs & Si' (mixed), colour 'H to J' (mixed). Dimensions = 1.45mm(L) x 1.20mm(W) x 0.65mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest) Dimensions = 2.15mm(L) x 1.25mm(W) x 0.80mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest) Total Weight = 0.30ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.06 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 0.80ct - Total Metal Weight = 3.90 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
