Item 1

One, hand-assembled, 14ct yellow gold and 14ct white gold, multistone, gem set ring. Plain, narrow, tapered band of 2.72mm in width (at base) x 1.06mm depth, with a curved and pierced underrail.

Feature white gold four 'corner' claws, housing four Princess cut diamonds, invisible set. Secured between the extended shoulders of the yellow gold plain and polished band. Each shoulder having nine baguette cut diamonds, tapering in size, channel set. The single row either side of the band having nine round brilliant cut diamonds, also tapering in size and channel set.



Polished finish - stamped '14K MHJ(partial) - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Finger size is P.

Four invisible set Princess cut diamonds, clarity 'Si', colour 'H to I' (mixed).
