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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold, gem set, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 2.76mm width (at base) x 0.89mm depth, with a hollow top and shoulders, open back settings, and a curved underrail. Feature assymetrical cluster style ring, with a central four claw setting, housing one oval natural ruby, claw set. Surrounding is one row of round brilliant cut diamonds, bead set, and one row of tapered baguette cut natural rubies, channel set. All of the gemstones graduate in size. There is a total of twenty-two rubies, and tenty-one round brilliant cut diamonds. To the bottom of these rows, is three tepered baguette cut diamonds, claw set.



Polished finish. Stamped '95 1 2(partial)' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: M. The ring contains:

One claw set oval shaped natural ruby, colour is "red".

Dimensions = 6.82mm(L) x 5.16mm(W) x 2.84mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.84ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Three claw set tapered baguette cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 3.62mm(L) x 1.20mm(W) x 0.88mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 4.17mm(L) x 1.39mm(W) x 1.01mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.11ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twenty Two channel set tapered baguette cut natural rubies, colour is "red".

Dimensions = 1.20mm(L) x 1.00mm(W) x 0.61mm(D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 3.58mm(L) x 2.46mm(W) x 1.50mm(D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.65ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twenty One bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.10mm(Dia) x 0.67mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.85mm(Dia) x 1.13mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.34ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 7.68 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 2.94ct Total Metal Weight = 7.09 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
