## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

## Item 1

One lady's, raised 10ct yellow gold & diamond set, multistone ring, of cast construction. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 1.89mm width (at base) x 1.01mm depth, with split underrail, open back settings, underreath.

Feature, "single graduating row" across the top. Housing seven round brilliant cut diamonds, channel set. The extended shoulders, of the band, taper up, splits to each side forming the channel setting to top, from both sides.

Polished finish, stamped \*10K 0.50 michael hill\* - acid tested as approximately 10 carat gold.

Finger size = N+.

The ring contains;

Seven channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "light brown tint", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 2.50mm (average diameter) x 1.53mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.70mm (average diameter) x 1.65mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 2.80 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.50ct, Total Metal Weight = 2.70 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited germological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the germstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the germstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the germstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
