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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 9ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, diamond set, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, wide, low half round, tapered band of 4.44mm width (at base) x 1.14mm depth, with a hollow top, open back settings, and a decorative pierced underrail.

Feature central domed setting housing nineteen round brilliant cut diamonds, bead set. Surrounding is one row of eighteen round brilliant cut diamonds, bead set. The setting is secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band, which have raised outer edges. Rhodium plating to all of the setting areas.



Polished finish.

Stamped '375 Z' - acid tested as 9 carat gold.

Ring size Z +3.

The ring contains:

Thirty Seven bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed.

Dimensions = 1.20mm(Dia) x 0.73mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.60mm(Dia) x 0.98mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.55ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 9.20 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.55ct Total Metal Weight = 9.09 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
