Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One lady's, hand-assembled raised, 10ct white gold & diamond set, cluster dress ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 2.23mm width (at base) x 1.39mm depth, with cut-out underrail. Feature, "cluster style" ring, with shoulder stones. Comprising, a raised cluster setting to top, Drops to a surround. The extended shoulders, of the band, tapers up wide to the top. Each shoulder having three rows of diamonds, all claw set, both sides.

Polished finish, stamped "10K micheal hill, 1.00" - acid tested approximately 10 carat gold. Finger size = J1/2.



The ring contains;

Seven claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P2 & P3"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 2.20mm (average diameter) x 1.34mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.48mm (average diameter) x 1.51mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.20ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Thirty claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P2 & P3"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.69mm (average diameter) x 1.03mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.00mm (average diameter) x 1.22mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.60ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Forty Two claw set single cut diamonds, clarity is "P2 & P3"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 0.08mm (average diameter) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.20mm (average diameter) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.20ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 3.80 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.02ct, Total Metal Weight = 3.60 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited germological testing inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gernstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gernstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gernstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
