Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One lady's, hand-assembled raised, 18ct yellow gold & platinum, diamond set, multistone ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures, 1.09mm width (at base) x 1.28mm depth, with curved underrail, open back settings, underneath.

Feature, raised four claw platinum setting to top, centre, houses one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Drops to each shoulder, a bow style vintage design, each shoulder contains, four single cut diamonds, bead set. The extended shoulders, of the yellow gold band, tapers up to the top, from both sides.



Polished finish, stamped "W.D. 18ct, Plat" - acid tested as 18 carat-gold. Finger size = O.

The ring contains;

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si", colour is "I", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 3.86mm (Diameter) x 2.35mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.20ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Eight bead set single cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.20mm (average diameter) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.55mm (average diameter) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.10ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 2.60 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.30ct, Total Metal Weight = 2.54 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited germological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gernstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
