Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, diamond set, multistone, 'cluster' style ring, of cast

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 2.15mm width (at base) x 1.12mm depth, with open back settings.

Feature five central rectangle settings, spanning across the top of the band, tapering in size from the centre. Each of the settings houses four Princess cut diamonds, invisibly set. The five settings are secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band. Rhodium plating to all settings areas.



Polished finish.

Stamped '750 E' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: N.

The ring contains:

Twenty invisibly set Princess cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs, Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed). Dimensions = 1.17mm(L) x 1.17mm(W) x 0.83mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest) Dimensions = 1.65mm(L) x 1.65mm(W) x 1.17mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest) Total Weight = 0.32ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.90 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.32ct Total Metal Weight = 4.84 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
