Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One lady's, raised 14ct white gold & diamond set, cluster dress ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 2.90mm width (at base) x 1.08mm depth with cut-out underrail. Feature, raised six claw setting to top, Illusion claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band, tapers up with roll-over coller terminations, channel set, both sides. Each shoulder having three rows, channel set centre, claw set outers.

Polished finish, stamped "14K IKS" - acid tested as 14 carat gold. Finger size = L.



One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P1", colour is "I", medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 3.60mm (Diameter) x 2.20mm (D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.18ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Six illusion claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "I to J" (mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 2.80mm (average diameter) x 1.71mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.90mm (average diameter) x 1.77mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Thirty claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2"(mixed), colour is "I to J"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.40mm (average diameter) x 0.85mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.60mm (average diameter) x 0.98mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.45ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Sixteen channel set tapered baguette diamonds, clarity is "P1, P2 & P3"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Average dimensions = 1.80mm (L) x 1.10mm (W) x 0.80mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Average dimensions = 1.90mm (L) x 1.70mm (W) x 1.24mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.32ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 6.20 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.45ct, Total Metal Weight = 5.92 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
