Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 9ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, cluster style, gem set, dress ring.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.67mm in width (at base) x 1.12mm depth, with open back central setting, with hollow shoulders.

Feature rhodium plated 'cluster' style setting, housing one illusion plate, claw set to the setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, illusion set. Surrounded by six single cut diamonds, illusion set, and six tapered baguette cut diamonds, end set, alternating.



Polished finish - stamped '375 JP88' - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Finger size is M.

The ring contains:

One illusion set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity 'P1', colour 'K'.

Dimensions = 2.00mm(Dia) x 1.22mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.03ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Six claw set single cut diamonds, clarity 'Si', colour 'J to L' (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.00mm (average diameter)

Total Weight = 0.03ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Six end set tapered baguette cut diamonds, clarity 'Si', colour 'I to J' (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 2.00mm(L) x 1.02mm(W) x 0.60mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.07ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 1.50 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 0.13ct - Total Metal Weight = 1.47 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
