

CERTIFICATE OF VALUATION



Description: An 18ct, stamped 750 white gold thirteen diamond ring.

The large diamond is four corner claw set in the centre with a row of channel set diamonds surrounding. The shoulders are park lane design and the flat band measures 3.85mm to 4.80mm in width. Hand made. Ring Size: O1/2.

Measurements:

1 x Diamond – princess cut, 5.16mm x 5.35mm x 4.20mm, estimated weight 0.95ct, Clarity SI1, Colour K.

12 x Diamonds – princess cut, 2.95mm x 2.95mm x 2.1mm estimated weight 0.15ct each, Clarity SI, Colour K, two are chipped.

Due to market volatility at this date, this item may require revaluation once the market stabilises.

Due to the stones being set the weight, clarity and colour are estimated. Total Diamond Weight: 2.75ct.
